Features

- High instep makes it easy to get the overboot on and off
- No outside laces for locking the boot
- Light weight, only 848 grams (size 41/42)
- Fits most types of combat shoes

Top section

Material

- Woven polyester/cotton

Properties

- Breathable fabric
- Waterproof YKK zipper
- Velcro cover for zipper

Locking of top

- Outside fix-lock system

Middle section

Material

- Reinforced PU-coated pile
- Unique knitted and coated fabric

Properties

- Water proof
- Cold insulation
- High abrasion properties
- Maintain softness down to -30°C

Locking overboot to combat shoe

- Inside locking laces

Bottom section

Material

- Polyurethane

Properties

- Maintain softness down to -30°C
- Withstands 50 000 flexes at -25°C
- Good slip resistance

For skiing

- Groove in the sole part for attachment of ski bindings



Other features

- Light and soft
- Requires little space
- Easy to pack
- Can be folded
- Easy to keep clean

User advice

- Use the overboot by low activity, i.e. by field accommodation etc.
- Do not wait until the point of when you feel freezing

Maintenance

- Keep clean of snow and dirt before use
- Do not store rolled for long time
- Remove the sole before storage
- Clean the overboot after use
- Wash by hand at 40°C, no dry clean or use of Iron
